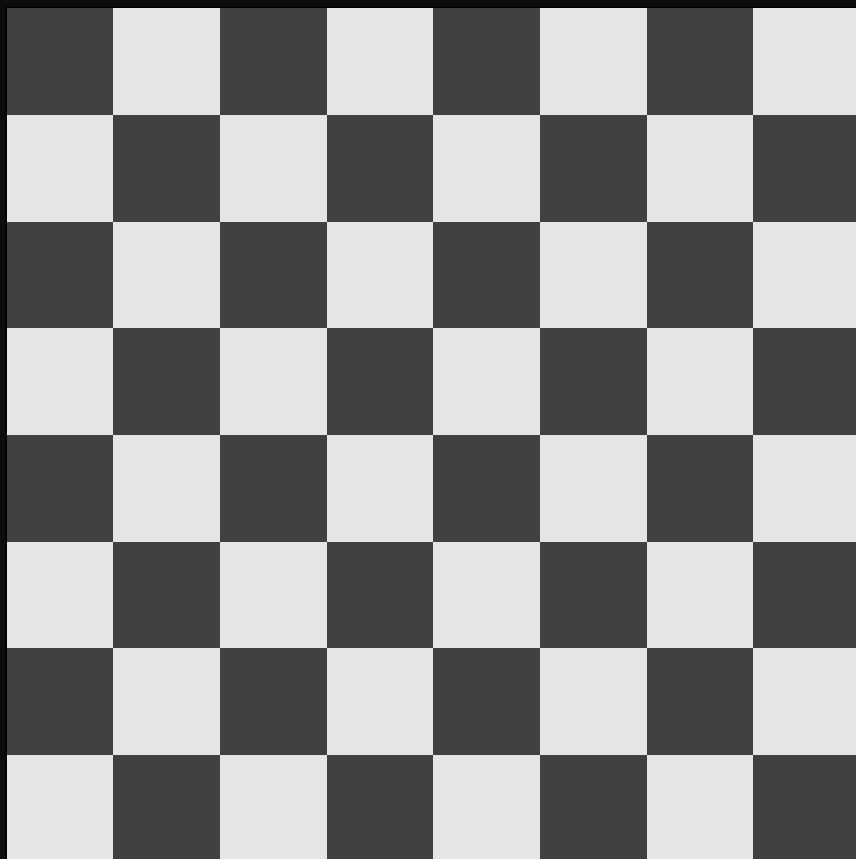

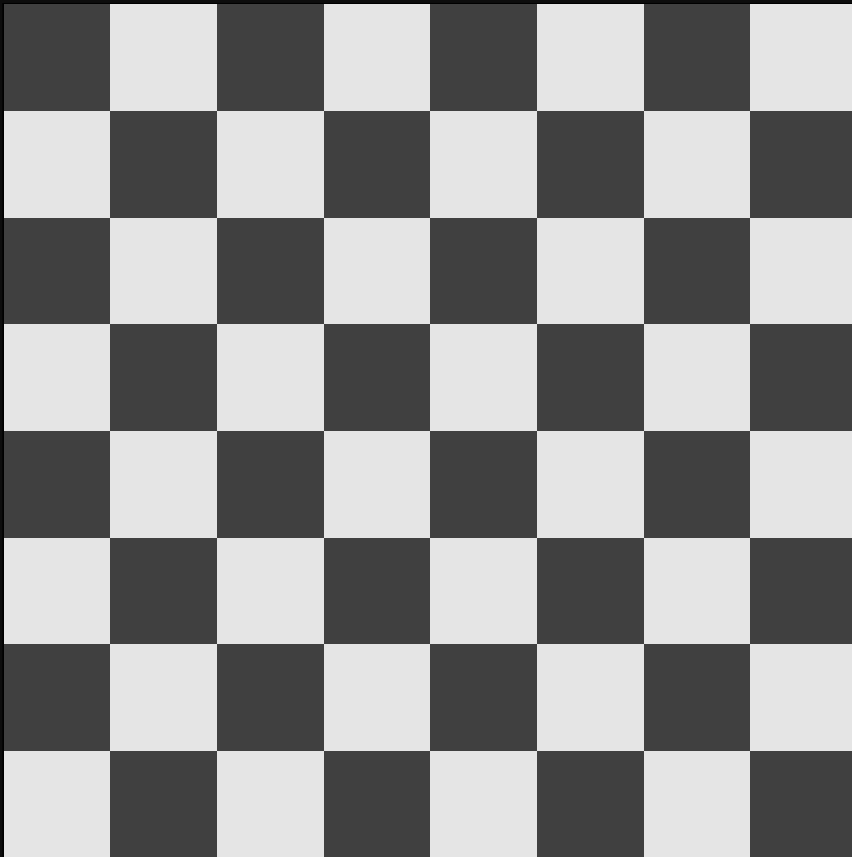

Across the 50 games analyzed, a clear pattern emerges in your transition from opening to middlegame. While you memorize opening lines well (avg 82% accuracy in move 1-12), you frequently struggle with pawn breaks once the theory ends.

Specifically, in complex, closed positions (like the French Advance or certain Caro-Kanns), you tend to push pawns prematurely on the queenside, weakening your structure. This specific tactical oversight costs you approximately 120 rating points.

In time pressure (under 1 minute), your blunder rate spikes by 400%, with a heavy blindspot for knight forks. Improving your time management in the early middlegame will preserve crucial seconds for the endgame.

4-Week Improvement Blueprint

- **Week 1: Tactics & Blindspots**

Complete 50 daily puzzles focusing EXCLUSIVELY on knight forks.

- **Week 2: Opening Overhaul**

Pause the Sicilian. Play 1...e5 against 1.e4 and focus on solid principles.

- **Week 3: Middlegame Planning**

Study 'pawn breaks' in closed positions. Review 5 master games.

- **Week 4: Time Management**

Play Rapid (15+10) instead of Blitz. Force yourself to use 10 mins by move 20.
